

Adult & Minor Amateur Athletic Waiver And Release of Liability

In consideration of being allowed to participate in any way in the related events and activities, the undersigned:

1. Agree that parent(s) or legal guardian(s) will instruct the minor participants that prior to participating, and/or participant, he or she should inspect the facilities and equipment to be used and if the participant believes anything is unsafe, he or she will immediately advise his or her coach or supervisor of such condition(s) and refuse to participant.
2. Acknowledge and fully understand that each participant will be engaging in activities that involve risk of serious injury, including permanent disability and death, and even social and economic losses which might result not only from their own actions, inactions or negligence but the actions, inactions or negligence of others, the rules of play, or the condition of the premises or of any equipment used. Further, that there may be other risks not known to us or not reasonably foreseeable at this time.
3. Assume all the foregoing risks and accept personal responsibility for the damages following such injury, permanent disability or death. I fully understand that any medical treatment given will be first aid treatment type only.
4. Release, waive, discharge and covenant not to sue Christian Karate Academy, LLC, d. b. a. Family Martial Arts, LLC, it's officers, agents or employees, other participants, sponsoring agencies, owners and lessees of each of the undersigned, his or her heirs and next of kin for any and all claims, demands, losses or damages on account of injury including death or damage to property, caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the releasee or otherwise. I consent that any pictures furnished by me or any pictures taken of me in connection with the Tournament can be used for publicity, promotion or television showing now or in the future, and I waive compensation in regard thereto.

BRIEF SUMMARY OF POINT SPARRING RULES

- (Details given at Black Belt Mtg.)
- 2 minute rounds: 8 point wins
 - 1 point for legal hand techniques
 - 2 points for legal kicks to head
 - 1 point for penalty points
- Legal Target Areas: Light touch to head (not face). Only as much contact as necessary to score to ribs, chest, abdomen, collarbone, and kidneys.
- Illegal Target Areas: Spine, back of neck, throat, sides of neck, groin, hips, legs, knees, and back.

Absolutely **NO**: Head butts, hair pulls, bites, scratches, elbows, knees, eye attacks, take downs of any kind, stomps, kicks to the head of downed opponent, slapping, grabbing, uncontrolled blind strikes—like (no look) spinning back first. **Liability Release and Registration must be completed.** Director reserves the right to combine divisions with a low number of participants—this will be done only if absolutely necessary with efforts to keep competitors close in experience together.
